**THE INAUGURAL RECIPIENT OF THE IRWIN SMIGEL PRIZE
IN AESTHETIC DENTISTRY: DR. RONALD E. GOLDSTEIN**

By every measure, the perfect candidate for the distinction of receiving the first Irwin Smigel Prize in Aesthetic Dentistry is Dr. Ronald E. Goldstein. By presenting to Ronald Goldstein this singular award, New York University College of Dentistry puts the genuine stamp on it for all future recipients.

Dr. Goldstein is clinical professor of oral rehabilitation at the Medical College of Georgia, an adjunct clinical professor of prosthodontics at Boston University, a visiting professor of oral and maxillofacial imaging and continuing education at the University of Southern California, and an adjunct professor of restorative dentistry at the University of Texas Health Science Center.

Dr. Goldstein has presented continuing education courses at more than 20 universities and lectured at over 300 dental meetings in the United States, Canada, South America, Australia, Asia and throughout Europe. He is a contributor to 10 published textbooks, the coauthor of four other textbooks, and the author of *Esthetics in Dentistry*. His consumer guide, *Change Your Smile*, now in its third edition, has sold more than

a million copies and has been translated into six languages.

As resident dental consultant for the television show, "P.M. Magazine" for three years, Dr. Goldstein produced more than 70 consumer-oriented programs on all phases of dentistry. He has also been featured in 30 dental video productions. His "Anterior Fixed Restoration Esthetic Principles," produced for the American Dental Association, won the 1982 John Muir Medical Film Festival Award for Dentistry.

Dr. Goldstein is a cofounder and past president of the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and the current president of the International Federation of Esthetic Dentistry. He was the first recipient of the Charles L. Pincus Award of the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and a recipient of the Outstanding Contribution to Esthetic Dentistry Award presented by the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry. In 1997, Dr. Goldstein received the prestigious Alpha Omega International Dental Fraternity Award for meritorious contributions to dentistry and its allied sciences, joining past recipients Albert Einstein and Jonas Salk.
