“Since my childhood I have had very crooked teeth. This condition was a natural part of my make-up. Dr. David Garber saw the potential of my smile, but he was adamant about taking a conservative and natural approach,” Cb explains. “Because he was trained in both periodontics and prosthodontics, I trusted his perspective. He advised me to begin with straightening my teeth, followed by tooth-colored crowns and porcelain veneers which retained ‘my signature look.’ I didn’t want drastic changes -- just subtle and natural enhancements to the smile that was ‘me.’”

Cb adds, “Of course I was hesitant to be put in braces, but it was actually my wife who encouraged me to take that route to straighten my crooked teeth -- and it’s one of the things she’s been right about!” GG&S orthodontist Dr. Maurice

Cb considers GG&S one of Atlanta’s best kept secrets! The group, which is equally popular with Hollywood stars, professional athletes and Atlanta-area locals, uses leading-edge technology and materials to custom-design smiles. Their goal is to complement a patient’s appearance and lifestyle while considering individual preferences. Dr. Ronald Goldstein, Dr. David Garber and Dr. Maurice Salama lead the one-of-a-kind practice, which includes five dentists who are also professors at leading dental schools. Other Team Atlanta members are Dr. Angela Gribble Hedlund, Dr. Maha El-Sayed, Dr. Henry Salama, and Dr. Brian Beaudreau.

Most dentists are classified as “general dentists,” while others continue their training in a specialty field, such as orthodontics, periodontics or prosthodontics. A two-specialty certification,

however, is rare in the profession. At Goldstein, Garber and Salama, three dual-degreed specialists are on staff, making it one of the only practices in the world with this breadth of expertise. For patients, this assures a “big-picture” approach to virtually every problem.

In addition to treating patients in their state-of-the-art facility in the Galleria area of north Atlanta, Team Atlanta dentists are dedicated to sharing their knowledge and techniques with other dentists. In recent months they have lectured in Argentina, Romania, Poland, Spain, Italy and France.

unique approach

Dr. Ronald Goldstein’s approach to esthetics encourages consideration of the entire face before addressing individual teeth. He often consults with the patient’s plastic or maxillofacial surgeon to assure a cohesive treatment plan. This strategy helps ensure a successful and pleasing result for each patient.

“Your smile should convey the very personal image you wish to show the world,” explains Dr. Garber. “The biggest

mistake I see people make is to perpetuate an unattractive smile,” he adds. “They go from dentist to dentist, looking for that ideal smile, but settling for a ‘one-tooth-at-a-time’ strategy — a new filling here, replacing a crown there, or bonding a chipped tooth.” The wiser choice, he suggests, is to approach the treatment holistically, starting with a face and smile analysis.

Cb Miles agrees and believes that this approach resulted in the smile he’s always wanted and can enjoy for years to come. “I love the increased confidence I feel when I meet with clients or vendors, as well as socially day-in and day-out.”
